CONDUCTING EXHIBITS

No drawing, raffles, or quiz-type contests of any type will be permitted. No bags or containers for collection of samples are to be distributed by an exhibitor. This applies to any envelope, folder, portfolio, box, etc., that provides carrying space for more than a single sample. Electrical or other mechanical apparatus must be muffled so that noise does not interfere with other Exhibitors. Character of the exhibits is subject to the approval of the Society. The right is reserved to refuse applications, which do not meet standards required or expected, as well as the right to curtail exhibits or parts of exhibits, which reflect against the character of the meeting. This applies to displays, literature, advertising, novelties, souvenirs, conduct of person, etc.

MUTUAL INDEMNIFICATION

Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold PUNS, Nationwide Children's Hospital, and parent companies, directors, agents and employees harmless against any and all claims, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of or relating to the other's performance under this agreement.

INSURANCE

All property of the exhibitor remains under their custody and control in transit to and from the exhibit hall and while it is in the confines of the exhibit hall. Neither Show Management, its service contractors, the management of the exhibit hall nor any of the officers, staff members or directors of any of the same are responsible for the safety of the property of exhibitors from theft, damage by fire, accident, vandalism or other causes, and the exhibitor expressly waives and releases any claim or demand he may have against any of them by reason of any damage to or loss of any property of the exhibitor. It is recommended that exhibitors obtain adequate insurance coverage, at their own expense, for property loss or damage and liability for personal injury.

FIRE PROTECTION

The Exhibitor, hired contractors, and others attending the event must comply with all applicable federal, state and local fire and building codes as well as hotel rules and regulations, policies and procedures.

PROTECTION OF THE FACILITY

Nothing shall be posted, nailed, or screwed, or otherwise attached to columns, walls, floors, or other parts of the Hotel or its furniture. Distribution of promotional gummed stickers or labels is strictly prohibited. Anything in connection therewith necessary or proper for the protection of the building, equipment, or furniture will be at the expense of the exhibitor.

INFRINGEMENT

Interviews, demonstrations, and the distribution of literature or samples must be made within the area assigned to the exhibitor. Canvassing or distributing of advertising matter outside the exhibitor's own space will not be permitted.
